Set within 25 acres of mixed ancient woodland, lawns, ponds and gardens, the Community is home to over seventy people and offers a rich, collaborative and purposeful working environment.

This role offers a rare opportunity to take stewardship of an established walled garden, producing vegetables, flowers and herbs for the Community, while also helping shape an exciting future expansion into adjacent land. You will play a central role in developing social farming and gardening opportunities that support wellbeing, learning and connection to the land.
